INSTRUCTIONS: The applicant package must be complete and arranged in the order described below. All transcripts, letters of recommendation and other documents must be sent to the State Chairman by the deadline in a single package as described. If your school requires that any documents be sent to another party, the applicant must arrange with the sponsoring chapter to receive the documents and forward them with the application in one package, opened and stapled, to the State Chairman before the deadline. Typewritten applications and statements are preferred. **DO NOT SUBMIT A PERSONAL PHOTOGRAPH.** The scholarship is judged and awarded without regard to race, religion, sex, national origin and disability.

1. Letter from sponsoring chapter
2. Scholarship Application (this paper)
3. Financial Need Form
4. Applicant must prepare a statement of 1,000 words or less setting forth his/her career objectives specifying how a college major (if requires) or college plans relate to future professional goals, and reasons for these choices.
5. Transcript of high school or college grades (as applicable). High School transcripts must indicate class rank, class size and test scores.
6. List on one side of 8 ½” x 11” paper, extra-curricular activities, honors received scholastic achievements or other significant accomplishments. Maximum-2 pages.
7. Dated, signed letters of recommendation from at least two but not more than four persons in authority from the high school or college you now attend or employers who are familiar with your work. Letter may cover the applicant’s ability, work habits, integrity and potential.
8. Photocopy of birth certificate or naturalization papers.
9. Application package should be stapled in the top, left-hand corner. Number of pages in the package must not exceed 15.
