## *National Society Daughters of the American Revolution*

Founded in 1890, the Daughters of the American Revolution is a service organization to promote **Patriotism, Historic Preservation, and Education**. One of the largest women's organizations in the world, the DAR has about **170,000 members in over 3,000 chapters** located in the United States and ten other countries.

**Membership in the DAR is open to any woman over the age of eighteen who can prove lineal descent from an ancestor who aided in achieving American Independence.**

Current Colorado Chapter membership ranges in age from 18 to 94 and includes 120 members.

An individual joins the DAR by invitation from a Chapter. She is accepted as a member of the National Society by action of the National Board of Management upon the successful completion, documentation and verification of her DAR application.

## Colorado Chapter, NSDAR

Colorado Chapter was organized in 1904, and the first Chapter Regent was **Mrs. Mary Goodell Grant, wife of State Governor, the Hon. James Grant**. Since then, the members of Colorado Chapter have played a significant role in the history of both Denver and the state of Colorado.



Colorado Chapter meets **monthly** from **September** through **May, usually** at the **Denver Country Club**. Each regular meeting includes coffee and dessert, a business session and program. Some meetings are replaced with special events, parties or tours of historic locations or notable locations in Colorado.
