LONGS PEAK CHAPTER.....

- 1951** Purchased two canvas banners emblazoned with “DAR” and “Longs Peak Chapter.”
- 1954** Had three pages of ads in the DAR magazine.
- 1966** Bestowed the Chapter Charter to the Longmont Pioneer Museum.
- 1981** Initiated bake sales at the Strawberry Festival and Pumpkin Pie Days to raise funds for DAR projects.
- 1990** Honored the 100th Anniversary of the NSDAR by planting a purple ash tree in Collyer Park.
- 1992** Planted two oak trees in honor of the Columbus Quincentennial at Central School.
- 1996** Put an emblem advisory sign on the Main Street Directory; helped install a time capsule beneath the new flag pole at the Longmont Public Library; and celebrated the 80th birthday of Longs Peak Chapter. Member Imogene Wagner worked tirelessly with the help of her HODAR Bill, member daughter Sandra Peif and her HODAR Garry, to install the sign and the time capsule. Imogene left our society March 27, 2004, to join her ancestors.
- 1998** Awarded the first Chapter Scholarship, renamed the Wilma Dunn Chapter Scholarship in 2002, in honor of Wilma’s dedication to starting our own scholarship fund.
- 1999** Planted a tulip poplar tree at the Callahan House in honor of the 200th anniversary of George Washington’s death.
- 2005** Members donated and planted rose bushes at Hover Home, replacing yellow Harrison Roses that had been removed during the Hover Street widening project.
