Elementary/Secondary Teacher Education Scholarship

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen and resident of the State of Colorado and attend an accredited college or university in the United States. **Applicants must obtain a letter of sponsorship from a DAR Chapter.** The scholarship will be judged and awarded without regard to race, religion, sex, national origin and disability. All awards are judged based on academic excellence, commitment to field of study (as required), and financial need by a committee of judges outside the NSDAR. The scholarship award is paid directly to the college or university of winner's choice upon proof of registration. No person shall receive any scholarship award more than once.

Please do not submit a personal photograph as the scholarship is judged and awarded without regard to race, religion, sex, national origin and disability. **The application should be submitted through the Colorado State Scholarship Chairman, Mary Daley.** Scholarships are paid directly to the school of the student's choice upon registration for year of the award.

All completed applications are due to the State Chairman by January 31, 2019 with awards presented at the annual State Conference.

Elementary/Secondary Teacher Education Scholarship

♦ **Awarded to an undergraduate or post graduate student who is majoring in an Elementary or Secondary School Teacher Education Program, as shown on a transcript or letter from the Dean of acceptance to the program.**

♦ **The minimum award is \$1,000.00 per year.**
